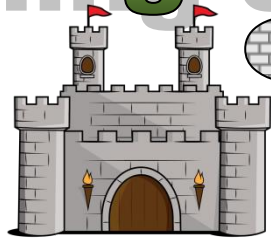


Learning Journey - Spring 2 2016



Castles



English

The children will be researching and presenting non-fiction information about Castles. They will also be telling their own tales of bold Knights.

Mathematics

The children will be applying their Mathematical learning to situations that would occur in Castle life to solve problems.

History

We will be learning about life in the past by looking at the features of castles and their functions. We will also be investigating the different people who worked in castles.

Science

Our main scientific topic will be Animals including Humans. Children will be identifying basic features and comparing different animals.

Week 1: William the Conqueror

The children will be learning about William the Conqueror as significant person in history.

Week 2: Knights adventure

The children will be telling their own tales of bold knights.

Week 3: Features of castles

We will be learning about the features of castles and why they were designed that way.

Weeks 4: People who worked in castles

We will be learning about the different jobs and roles in castles.

Week 5: Bodiam Castle Trip

We will be visiting a real castle and taking part in activities to help us understand what life was like in the Middle Ages.

PE

This term the children will be training as Knights, ready to display their skills in a Jousting tournament.

PSHE and RE

We will be learning about the events leading up to the Easter story.
In PSHE we will be thinking about the morals held by Knights and developing our own codes of conduct to help us be honourable people.

Computing

The children in Year 1 will continue learning about coding this term, creating and using instructions for a computer program.

Art and Design, Design and Technology, Music

We will be designing our own coat of arms to display on shields and exploring pattern by printing our own tiles. The children will make their own model castles with working drawbridges.
