

Physical Education & School Sport Premium Funding expenditure: Report to governors: 2016/17

What is Sport Premium Funding? An introduction

The Government is providing £150 million per year in order to improve the quality of sport and PE in schools. Each school will receive £8 000 plus an extra £5 per pupil each year. Schools will have to spend the sport funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this.

Aim

- To ensure that all children have the chance to experience a range of sports activities and are encouraged to adopt a healthy lifestyle.

Principles

- At Shipbourne School we believe in promoting a healthy lifestyle, and recognise the contribution that a varied PE curriculum can have.
- We encourage a range of sports across the key stages as part of the curriculum and within extra-curricular opportunities to stimulate children to 'have a go' and inspire further participation in sports outside of school.
- We believe this can have a positive influence on the concentration, attitude and academic achievement of all our children.

Effect and Attainment

All children participate in sport and at Shipbourne the attainment in sport is high, with children continuing in sports introduced by using this premium eg. gym, squash. For 2016/17 season, the netball squad have done especially well, winning all their matches within the collaboration.

Sustainability is achievable by involving parents to participate and teachers learning alongside the sports coaches.
