- No toys, smart watches etc. from home

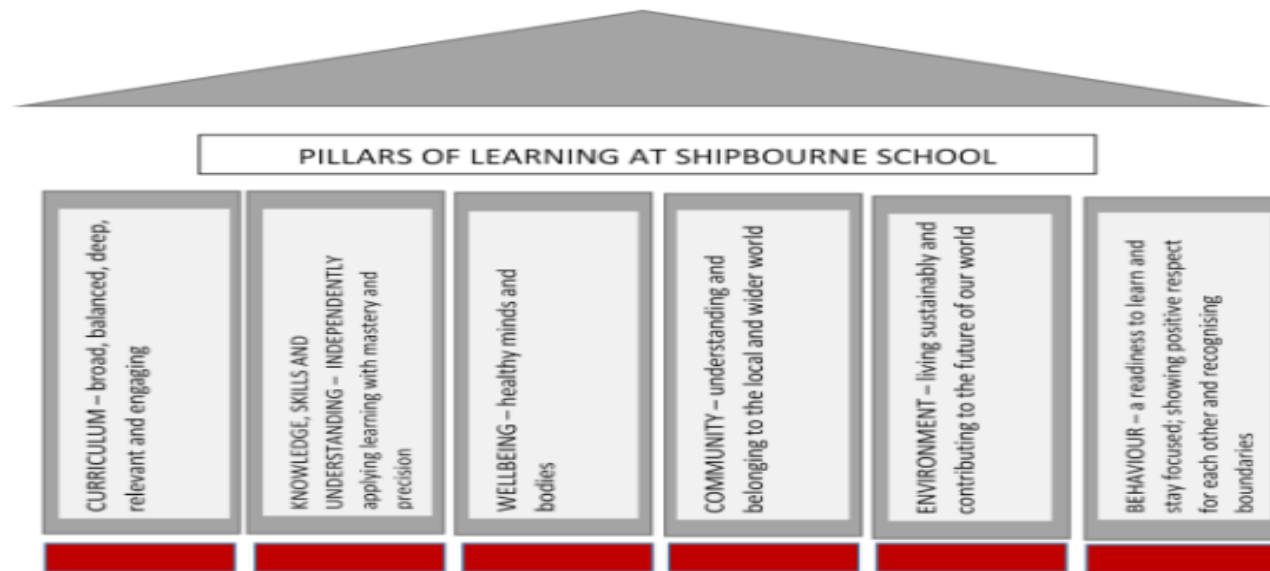
Classroom Expectations:
